Scottsbluff Expansion

Spirit Catholic Radio is excited to announce that we have begun broadcasting on Spirit 99.3-FM KETT. Spirit Catholic Radio was formerly heard in Western Nebraska on 95.1-FM KCTH-LP, on a low-power

FM station that reached approximately a 12-mile area. The 99.3-FM KETT signal will reach an approximately 60-mile radius, allowing more people to be reached by the network's programming.
